



Simple songs and stories with repetition are motivating activities for children with Autism. They are great learning activities as well. Adding technology can enhance them even further; giving us the opportunity to customize for an individual's learning style and visual cues.

The Sequencer works great for recording a series of messages, especially stories and songs. We recorded the song "If You're Happy and You Know It" into the Sequencer. A battery-adapted light is plugged into the Relay (using a Male-Male cable connector), and a Pal Pad is plugged into the switch input jack. When the Pal Pad is pressed, the Sequencer will play a message, and the light will stay activated for the length of that message.

This setup provides opportunity for the use of multiple visual cues: the book itself, the picture on the Sequencer, the light and the matching smiley face placed on the Pal Pad. These can be used all at once or in any combination.
